Board Minutes Summary

Financial and Strategic Planning

Leadership reviewed the organization's financial position and discussed refining the mission statement language. They emphasized strengthening the educational strategy, addressing gaps in mentoring emerging professionals, and increasing board engagement with in-person programs. Appreciation was expressed for ongoing leadership efforts and collaboration.

Board Strategy and Course Development

The board discussed expanding membership and updating course offerings. Potential new leadership roles and volunteer involvement were considered. Feedback on the education strategy included ideas for new courses, improvements to existing content, and updating outdated material.

Educational and Membership Initiatives

Plans were outlined to enhance educational programming and develop a membership platform with improved resources. Efforts are underway to standardize instructional materials and update course branding. International collaboration opportunities were also explored.

Mission and Organizational Direction

The group discussed modernizing the mission statement to reflect current environmental realities while maintaining a focus on healthy built environments. Members considered how to address broader environmental themes without creating unnecessary division, ultimately emphasizing professional training and public education.

Board Growth and Program Expansion

The board approved the addition of a new member pending further discussion and explored partnerships to expand educational reach. Plans include developing professional training media and continuing to grow course offerings and archived materials.
